TRANSPORT ASSISTANCE

Do you want to attend a social activity or appointment, go shopping or visit family or friends and you have no transport? We may be able to help find a way to get you there.

If eligible* we can:

- provide **information** about transport options
- assist by **coordinating** your transport connections to get you where you want to go
- **advocate** on your behalf (for example, if you need to change an appointment time)

**Eligibility for community transport varies, depending on the type of service required, but can include frail older people, carers, a person with a disability, or those who are isolated, with no access to private or public transport.*
